Prof. Dr. Hermann Berger represents the Department of Interventional Radiology of the Technical University Munich which is one of the host institutions of the Fifth World Congress in Biomechanics.

Born in 1949, Prof. Berger finished his studies at the Ludwigs-Maximilians-University Munich and received his doctorate in 1976. An eight-year training period followed at the Department of Radiology, Klinikum Großhadern, LMU Munich. In 1990, he became an associate professor at the Ludwig-Maximilian-University Munich. He was appointed full professor at the Technical University Munich in 1997. His practical experience of medicine is in the section of diagnostic and interventional radiology. He is head of the Department of Interventional Radiology of TU Munich, Klinikum Rechts der Isar.

In addition to his responsibilities, Dr. Berger is active in experimental research on oncology and vascular medicine and clinical research on interventional radiology. His primary focus is on loco-regional cancer treatment, percutaneous guiding techniques, endo-vascular reconstruction and the educational courses on clinical radiology, vascular medicine, and hepatobiliary medicine.

Prof. Dr. Hermann Berger is a member of several medical societies including the Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe, the American College of Angiology, the International Society for Endovascular Specialists, the International Gastro-Surgical Club, the German Roentgen Society, the Bavarian Roentgen Society, the German Cancer Society, the German Society of Angiology and the German Society of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery.
